1. Approve minutes of prior committee meetings.
2. Comments from the public.
3. COVID-19 epidemic response measures, including meetings logistics and operational impacts.
4. Winter storm recovery matters, including:
 - a. fee adjustment credit matters;
 - b. inspections, repairs, maintenance, weatherization, and related proposals; and

7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. current fund balances and flow of funds;

8. Water supply, Groundwater Reduction Plan, and Fort Bend Subsidence District regulatory matters, including reimbursement requests and water supply agreements.
9. Authority financing plan matters, including:
 - a. Water System Revenue Bonds and Water System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2021;
 - b. State Water Implementation Revenue Fund for Texas funding for regional projects, including escrow release applications;
 - c. Redemption of Series A Revenue Note; and

- d. Texas Water Development Board Clean Water State Revolving Fund funding for reuse projects, including escrow release applications, Loan Forgiveness Agreement Amendments, and single audit report compliance.

 - a. community outreach events, presentations, and mobile lab reservations;
 - b. public inquiries and requests;
 - c. development of Authority informational materials and meeting attendance;
 - d. educational programs;
 - e. purchase of outreach items;
 - f. marketing and public communication services, including website design;
 - g. budget for communication, public outreach, and conservation matters; and
 - h. memberships and conferences.
 11. W.I.S.E. Guys Irrigation System Evaluation program matters, including reports, surveys, and cost sharing agreements.
 12. Larry's Toolbox program and website matters, including:
 - a. program implementation;
 - b. participant inquiries/requests;
 - c. Authority funded irrigation system evaluations and water budgets, and related proposals, agreements, and invoices;
 - d. preparation and distribution of bill inserts and mailers; and
 - e. successful participant rebates.
 13. Water conservation program for new development, including proposals and agreements.
 14. Effluent reuse matters, including proposals, agreements, and project financing.
 15. Regional planning matters, including:
 - a. joint projects with West Harris County Regional Water Authority, including:
 - i. Bellaire Pump Station;
 - ii. Surface Water Supply project;
 - iii. Amended and Restated Joint Facilities Agreement; and
 - b. water supply from City of Houston, including O&M budgets and true-ups, Luce Bayou Project, and Northeast Water Purification Plant Expansion Project.

18. Convene Executive Session to: (i) discuss purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, and (ii) consultation with attorney pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code.
